

## The time to apply for the NCKU Distinguished International Student Scholarships in the Fall Semester of 2017/2018 Academic year

※ If you were a graduate student **who was first admitted for a Fall semester** (not a Spring semester), you may be eligible to apply for 2017 fall semester scholarship (from 2017 Sep. to 2018 Aug.). Please follow the procedure as given in the *Regulation of NCKU Distinguished International Student Scholarship*. ### ※ Applicant Eligibility:

**Former and continuing students:** Eligible applicants who are officially enrolled as international students and who have completed at least their first year of academic study with the following qualifications:

A. **Graduate students:** A graduate student who has completed all the required coursework should submit a thesis/dissertation proposal **and** a letter of recommendation by their advisor.

a. **Master's program:** Must have completed a minimum of 15 required course credits for graduation in the preceding academic year, with an average grade of 80 or above and without any official record of misconduct.

b. **Doctoral program:** Must have completed a minimum of one-third of the required course credits for graduation in the preceding academic year, with an average grade of 80 or above and without any official record of misconduct.

--> If the applicants do not meet these requirements, you cannot have this scholarship.

※ **All applicants should submit to Mrs. Huang (Rm.93556) before Aug. 25**

### ※ Note that “ \* ” indicates required!

- \*1. Application form
- \*2. Official university transcript
- \*3. Copy of the receipt/study certificate for the upcoming semester
- \*4. Copy of the valid ARC with one-year extension
- \*5. Copy of the post office bank account passbook
6. Recommendation letter from advisor/department professor—applies only to returning students or students who have completed all required coursework
7. Other relevant materials (thesis/dissertation proposal for the graduate student who has completed all the required coursework )

※ **Undergraduate students** do not need to submit application forms. ISAD will evaluate your academic performance after Sep. 18 and announce the award results before Sep. 30.
