Course Selection for Graduate Students

- All courses taken need to be approved by the research advisor. Each lab should turn in the course confirmation sheet at the end of 2nd and 3rd Stage of Course Enrollment in each semester (T-5-5 & T-5-6).
- 2. Only courses offered at graduate level, which do not include the courses offered by in-service Master/Ph.D. program and the joint courses for both inservice Master/Ph.D. students and Master/Ph.D. students, can be counted as credits required for graduation. For students who did not receive Bachelor degree in chemical engineering, please refer to the M.S. Requirements in the Department of Chemical Engineering at National Cheng Kung University (M-10-E) with the proper enrolled academic year for more details.
- 3. For students enrolled hereafter Academic Year 99, Only one language related course can be counted as credits required for graduation
- 4. For Master's program enrolled hereafter the Spring of Academic Year 107, a maximum of 12 credits from courses not offered by the Department of Chemical Engineering can be counted as credits required for graduation.
- 5. Graduate students shall enroll in a minimum of one course regardless of credits for each semester (a special-topic seminar can also be considered as one course in this context). Those who have completed their coursework with the credits required for graduation are exempt from any course enrollment, with their transcripts for the semester specifying "in the thesis/dissertation-writing process." Qualified students need to apply the exemption (T-5-7 form) before the end of 3rd Stage of Course Enrollment in each semester.
